Competition Format

FLATWATER: Heats, semifinals and finals are held in each event where more than nine boats are entered. If nine or fewer boats are entered in a given event, all boats qualify directly to the final.

SLALOM: Competitors take two runs of the course in both the qualification and finals. The time of the two runs, plus any penalties, are added together in seconds, which equate to points. The person with the lowest total points wins.
