- **Olympic Solidarity Scholarships for Athletes "Beijing 2008"**

The Olympic Solidarity Program has awarded Olympic Scholarships for the Beijing Olympic Games in 2008 to 28 Canoe-Kayak athletes out of the total number of 712 approved scholarships. Olympic Solidarity is still in the process of analyzing a further 39 Canoe-Kayak candidature proposals.

The financial support to the selected athletes begins on the 1st of May 2006 and will remain operational until the Olympic Games in 2008 subject to the athletes qualifying for the Games.

The primary aim of the Olympic scholarships is for the athlete to qualify for the Beijing Olympic Games. We would therefore like to ask the awarded athletes and their federations to take specific care of this point and use all the possible efforts for this achievement.

Should any athlete to whom O.S. awarded scholarships be sanctioned for a doping offence in the lead up to the Beijing Olympic Games it will mean an automatic disqualification from the programme.
